**JOB FUNCTION:** Maintain city park(s), public grounds, and recreation facilities available to community residents.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Under direct supervision this position plants, installs and maintains turf in all city parks and recreation facilities and other facilities such as - baseball diamonds, parks, soccer fields, green belts etc.
- Operates various equipment in the maintenance of grounds such as: weed-eater, front cut riding mower, edger, backpack blower, sprayer, tractor, water truck, brush hog, push mower, slope mowers, front end loader, chain saw, dump truck, fogger, various hand tools, etc.
- Plant and maintain flowers beds, trees, shrubs and grass areas
- Trim shrubs and hedges
- Daily trash pick-up at various facilities
- Carpentry, setting forms, finishing concrete
- Construction of new play areas
- Builds or assembles park benches, picnic tables
- Replaces basketball, tennis nets
- Installs and takes down Christmas decorations
- Repairs broken irrigation systems
- Maintains swimming pool grounds and assists with facilities
- Seasonal preparation of infields and playing fields (softball, baseball and soccer)
- Festival set up and take down
- Applies fertilizer and pesticides
- Sprays herbicide
- Mows parks, rights of way and road sides
- Performs playground maintenance and inspection
- Removes paint and graffiti

- Other duties as assigned by Park Superintendent

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Valid Class C Texas Driver’s License
- Knowledge and skill in the operation of light equipment
- Physical condition to carry out the work tasks and a reasonable amount of eye to hand coordination

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS**

- Experience in carpentry, plumbing, and/or landscaping
- Knowledge and skill to operate heavy equipment
- Non-commercial pesticide applicators license
- 5 years in a parks system

**JOB DIMENSIONS**

- Maintain inventory level on maintenance truck
- Contact with internal and external customers, and contractors
- Communicates effectively, verbally and in writing
- Required to work hours other than regular schedule such as days, nights, weekends, holidays, on-call, and rotating shifts

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORKING CONDITIONS**

- Physical requirements include lifting up to 50 pounds occasionally
- Subject to standing, sitting, walking, climbing, bending, crawling, squatting, kneeling and working in cramped and strained positions for long periods of time to perform job scope
- Working conditions are primarily outside with frequent exposure to inclement weather; water/wastewater; mechanical, electrical, chemical and confined space hazards; offensive fumes; excessive noise; and animals, snakes and poisonous insects
- Required to comply with requirements for personal protective equipment
- Operates a company vehicle daily
