

ORDINANCE NO. 19-1222

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTON, TEXAS, DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICTS 1, 2 AND 3 AS ELECTED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 4, 2019 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THOSE OFFICES SHALL NOT BE HELD; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasanton adopted Ordinance No. 19-1220 on February 7, 2019 ordering a General Election to be held on May 4, 2019 for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Districts 1, 2 and 3; and

WHEREAS, the deadlines for filing for a place on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy for the City's General Election have expired; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052 of the Texas Election Code, has certified in writing to the City Council that Robert Leonhardt is unopposed for election to the office of City Councilmember, District 1, Kenneth A. Hernandez is unopposed for election to the office of City Councilmember, District 2, and Diana K. Prasifka is unopposed for election to the office of City Councilmember, District 3; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 2.053(a) of the Texas Election Code, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to their respective offices and shall be issued a Certificate of Election following the date on which their election was to have been:

COUNCILMEMBER, DISTRICT 1	ROBERT LEONHARDT
COUNCILMEMBER, DISTRICT 2	KENNETH A. HERNANDEZ
COUNCILMEMBER, DISTRICT 3	DIANA K. PRASIFKA

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 2.053(b) of the Texas Election Code, the General Election for Councilmembers Districts 1, 2, and 3 called and ordered by Ordinance No.19-1220 for May 4, 2019 shall not be held and is hereby cancelled.



Section 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby expressly repealed.


Section 5. This ordinance is adopted after one reading to meet the time requirements of the Election Code of the State of Texas.
